INTRODUCTION

The object of creating this document was to provide an easy source of reference for my future projects, allowing me to find information about various traditional board games in the books, papers and periodicals I have access to. The project began once I had finished The Traditional Board Game Series of leaflets, published on my web site. Therefore those leaflets will not necessarily benefit from information in many of the sources below.

Given the amount of effort this document has taken me, and would take someone else to replicate, I have tidied up the presentation a little, included this introduction and an explanation of the “families” of board games I have used for classification.

My sources are all in English and include a number of basic types: books on board games, other books, periodicals of papers, and individual papers published by academic or commercial institutions. I have avoided miscellaneous pages on the world wide web as the easiest way to filter out those flights of fancy which owe more to the imagination than to actual research. In doing so I have unfortunately excluded some good research published on-line, and included some bad research published on paper. But I think, on balance, that I am probably pointing myself and others generally in the right direction.

In one revision I decided to include “passing mentions” of the games in the references, where previously I included only works which have substantial information. In this I have

been very selective, and will include only those passing mentions of a game which give us useful information not available in the substantial accounts (for example, if they are proof of an earlier or later existence of a game than is mentioned elsewhere).

The use of this document by myself and others has been complicated by the facts that a name may have attached itself to more than one game, and that a game might be known by more than one name. I have dealt with this by including every name known to my sources, using one name as a “primary name” (for instance, *nine mens morris*), listing its other names there under the AKA heading, and having entries for each synonym refer the reader to the main entry. Extra care must be taken when cross-referencing: for instance, on looking up the name *akidada* the reader is expected to know what type of game he or she is researching, in order to look ahead to the appropriate entry.

This is, and always will be, a work in progress. It is likely to be expanded with each new book that becomes available to me. It is therefore possible that I will upload a revised edition every now and then. If you have suggestions, information or other comments, then please do not hesitate to send them to me by e-mail. 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THE GAME FAMILIES

In order to more easily identify the games, and to help disentangle from one another different games which have the same name, they have been categorised into families. Membership of a family does not necessarily imply any relationship to the other games in the family, apart from resemblance. The names are arbitrary but, in all but a few cases, have been quite widely used.

The categories are themselves loosely organised into four groups: race games, where players attempt to be the first to move their pieces to a certain point; war games, where players of equal strength try to be the first to overcome their opponents or opponents pieces; hunt games, where a player with a large force of weak pieces attempts to corner a player with a small force of strong pieces; and construction games, where players attempt to form a certain configuration with their pieces before the opponent does the same.

alquerque: war games played on a networked grid, where pieces are placed on points that are joined together by lines. The boards for these games come in a variety of shapes. Pieces generally move from one point to the next along a marked line, and a piece is captured by leaping over it to the empty point beyond.

ashtapada: race games played on a square board, usually by four players. Pieces race around the board on a spiral path, each players path being rotated so as to start at his own side of the board. Because the paths are therefore different, they cannot be marked on the board but must be remembered by the players.

chess: war games in which each player has an array of major pieces of different types. In front of these pieces is a row of foot soldiers of limited power. The object for each player is usually to trap a designated enemy piece (usually a king), rather than mere material capture.

dara: war games played on a square grid. The game starts with the board empty. In an initial phase, players place pieces from their hand onto the board, and in a second phase pieces are moved from one space to an adjacent

space. Forming a row of three allows capture of an enemy piece, and the game is won by reducing the enemy to two pieces.

draughts: war games played on a square grid. The forces start massed at each end of the board, and pieces are initially restricted from moving backwards, in order to force the armies early into contact. Movement is to an adjacent square, with pieces reaching the opposite end of the board being promoted and allowed to move in all directions. A piece captures an enemy by jumping over it onto the empty square beyond, and the aim of the game is to capture all enemy pieces.

fox & geese: hunt games played on a cross shaped board formed by points with lines connecting them. A small number of prey pieces face a large number of hunters. All pieces move from one point to the next along a marked line, sometimes with movement restrictions for the hunters. The prey may capture a hunter by jumping over it onto the empty space beyond. The prey wins by capturing all the hunters, while the hunters win by hemming in the prey so that it cannot move.

go: games of placement, where the surrounding enemy pieces and territory gains captures or scores points.

go moku: a construction game played on the points of a square grid. Players place their pieces in turn, one at a time, onto an initially empty board. The first to form a row of five pieces of his own colour wins the game.

halma: race games played without luck. Each player starts with his pieces at his own end of the board, and attempts to be the first to move them to the opposite side. Pieces usually move to an adjacent square, but a piece may move more quickly by instead jumping over a piece of any colour to the adjacent space beyond, and jumping again and again if in a position to do so. Thus success in these games relies on skill in arranging the pieces to aid each other, instead of on the luck of dice.

hnefatafl: hybrid hunt/war games in which a small number of forces attempts to aid a king piece in his escape from a large force twice their

number. Pieces move orthogonally and an enemy piece is captured by surrounding it on two opposite sides by friendly pieces. The small force wins by moving the king to the periphery of the board, while the larger force wins by capturing the king.

horseshoe: war games on a grid of points joined by lines. Pieces move from one point to the next along a marked line, without powers of capture. The winner is the player who blocks his opponent so that he cannot move. So named because some boards have a gap in one side, thus being shaped like a horseshoe.

lasca: war games on chequered boards much resembling the draughts family. Pieces are all placed on squares of one colour, moving diagonally. A piece is captured by leaping over it onto the square beyond, but the captured piece is dragged along with its conqueror and placed underneath it at the end of the move. The game is won by the player who has captured all the enemy pieces.

latrunculi: war games played on a grid of squares. Pieces move orthogonally, and an enemy is captured by surrounding it on two opposite sides. The player who has captured all his opponents pieces wins the game.

leopard game: hunt games played on a triangular grid. Pieces are placed on points joined by lines, and move from one point to an adjacent point along a marked line. Generally the games start with the prey already on the board, but the hunters are placed, one at a time, while the prey are making their first moves around the board. Once the hunters are all placed, they may start to make their moves. The prey are powerful pieces who may capture a hunter by leaping over him onto the vacant square beyond. The prey wins by capturing all the hunters, while the hunters have to trap the prey. The grid may have extensions to its basic triangular shape.

mancala: war games played on boards formed of two, three or four rows of large holes, each hole capable of holding a large number of pieces. Pieces are moved by lifting them from one hole and sowing them, dropping them one each into subsequent holes along a predetermined path. Captures are made by various

arrangements of the pieces which vary from one mancala game to another. The game is usually won by the player who has captured the most pieces when no more moves can be made.

mehen: race games played on a spiral-shaped board.

merels: hybrid war/construction games played on a grid of points joined by lines. In an initial phase, pieces are placed by the players alternately, onto empty points on the board. When all are placed, pieces can move from one point to another on a marked line. Forming a row of three pieces allows the capture of an enemy pieces, and the first player to reduce his enemy to two pieces wins the game.

pachisi: race games played on a cross-shaped grid of squares. Four players take part, often in partnerships where players sitting opposite each other team up. Each arm of the cross usually has a width of three squares. Pieces race around the outer rows of squares around the periphery of the cross, proceeding up the inner rows of squares to the centre when they have made their circuit. The first player or partnership to get his pieces to the central square wins the game.

perugian game: hunt games played on a chess board. One or two powerful prey pieces start at one end of the board, while a larger number of weak hunter pieces starts at the other. Pieces move diagonally to an adjacent square, the hunters being restricted to forward movement. In some games, the prey may capture a hunter by leaping over it onto the empty square beyond, in which the prey wins by capturing all the hunters. In other games there is no capture, but the prey wins by reaching the opposite end of the board. The hunters win by trapping the prey so that it cannot move.

promotion game: race games where the object is the first to achieve a particular rank. The board is rectangular and arranged into a pattern of squares, which may not necessarily be of the same size. Squares have different effects upon the pieces that land on them, including promotion and demotion.

senet: race games played on an elongated grid of squares, usually in three rows. The pieces move along the squares in a predeter-

mined path, and a player wins by being the first to get all his pieces to the end of the course.

zohn ahl: race games played on a circle of playing spaces, usually 40 in number. The

cardinal points of the compass form the start and end points, and obstacles such as creeks.

Performance in these games is generally based completely on luck, with no skill element.
